**“Love one another as I have loved you.”** (John 13:34)

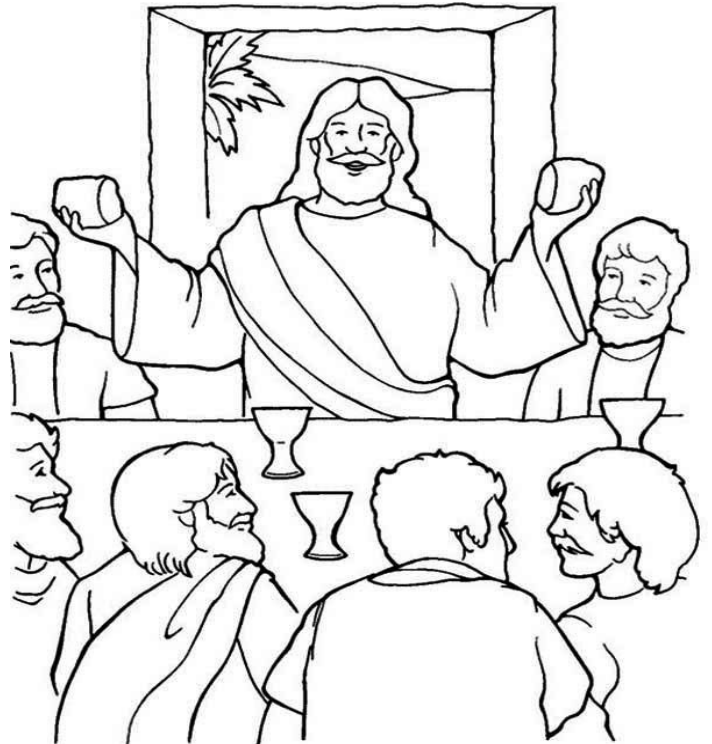
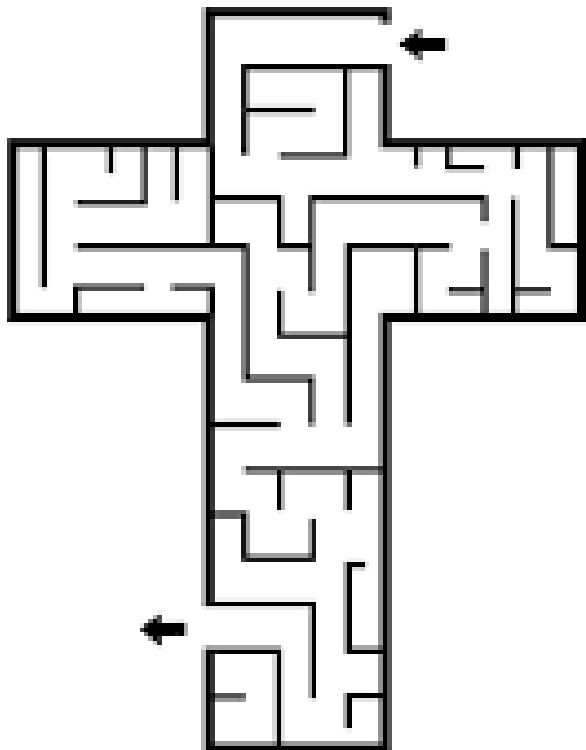
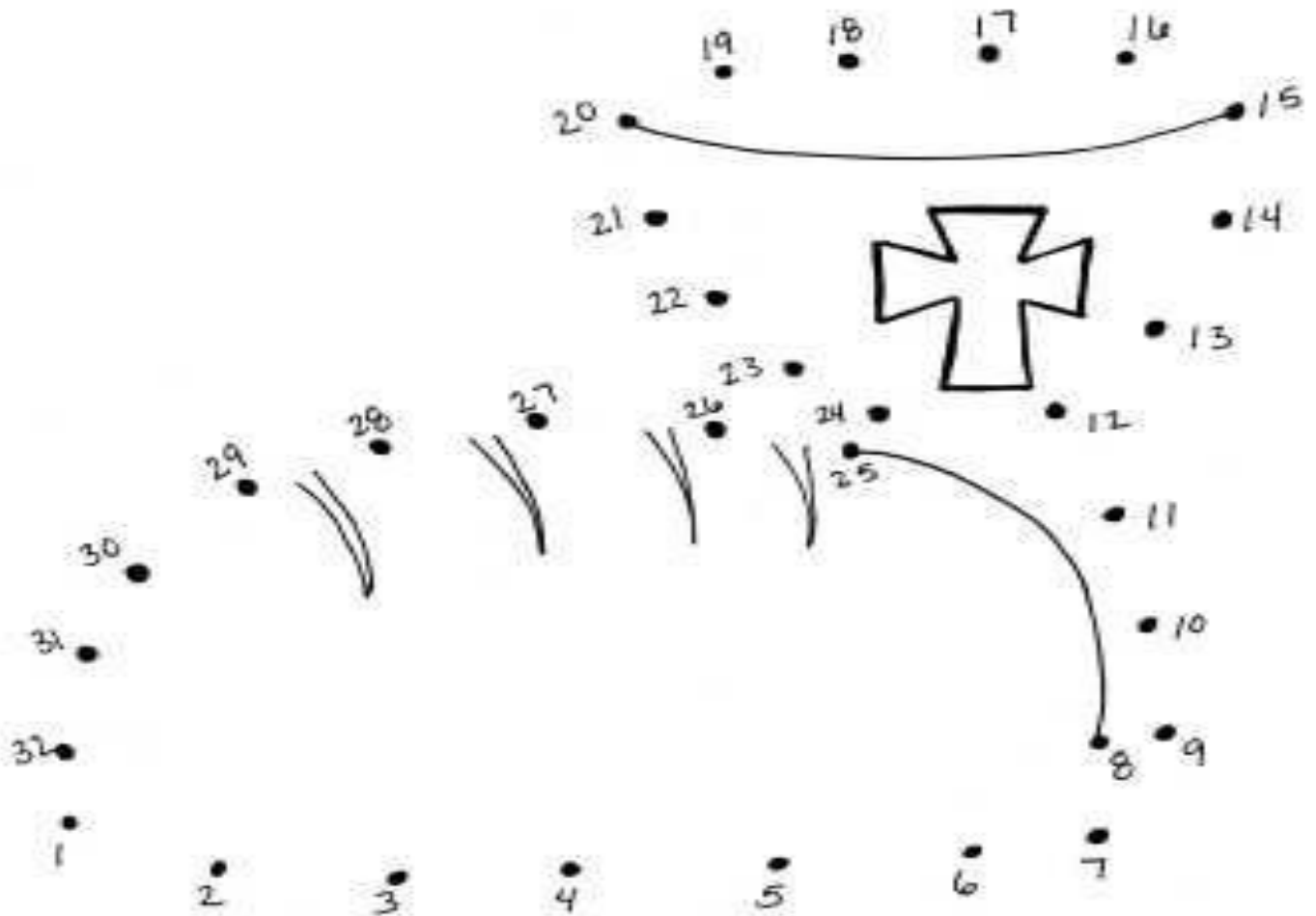


Jesus instituted Holy Communion, what we often call the Last Supper.

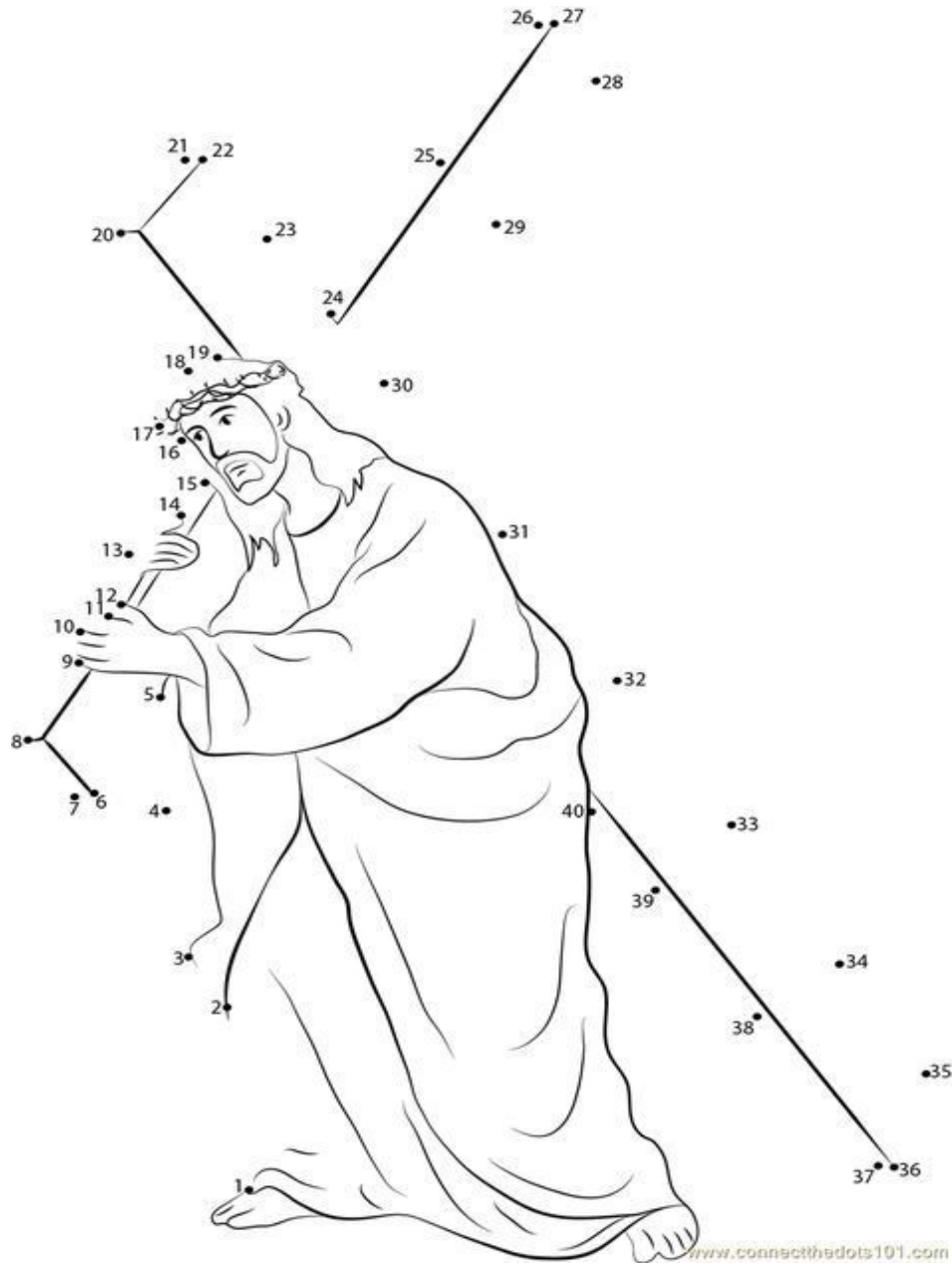

## Good Friday

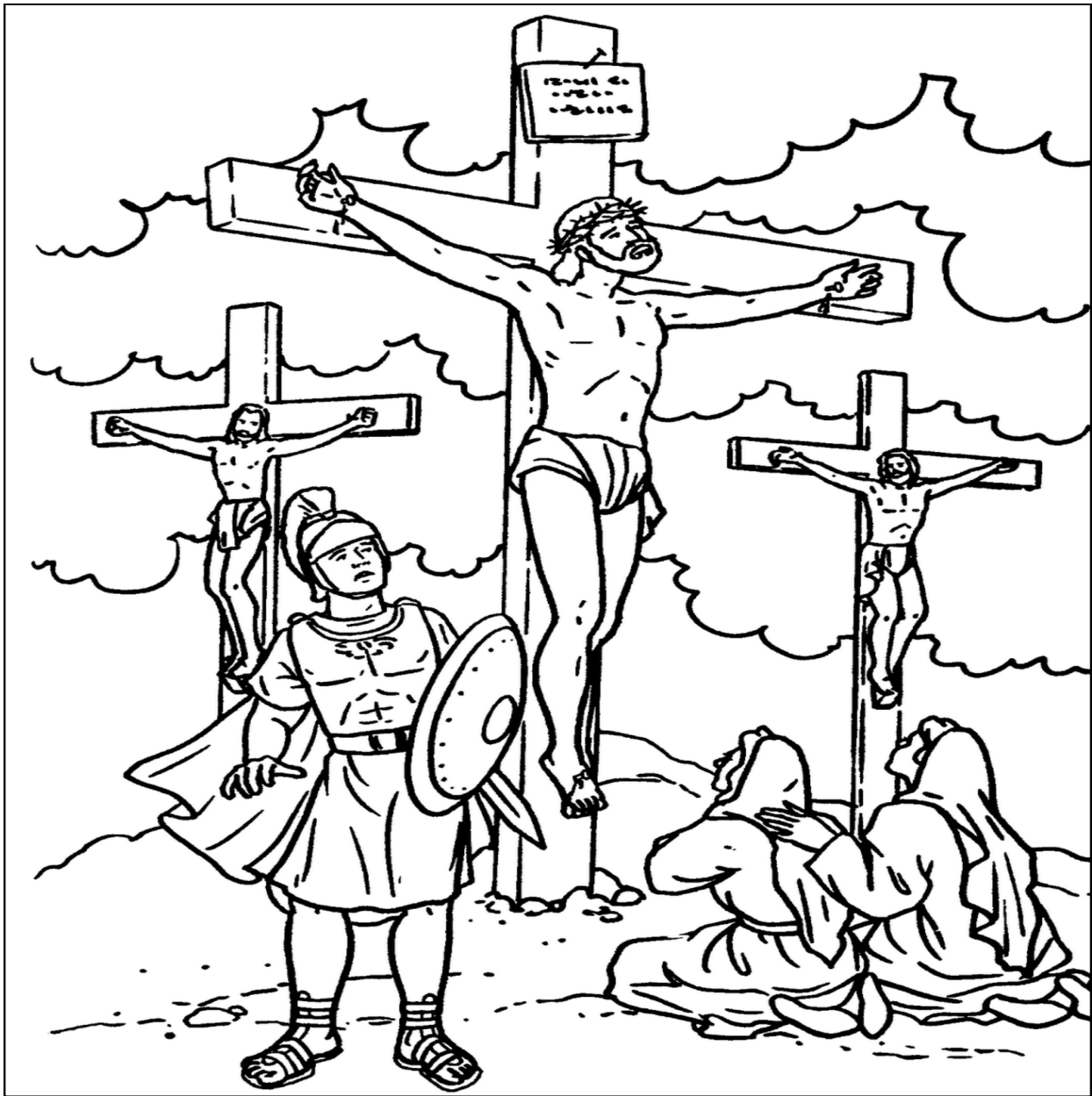
*Read what happened on Good Friday in Mark 15.*

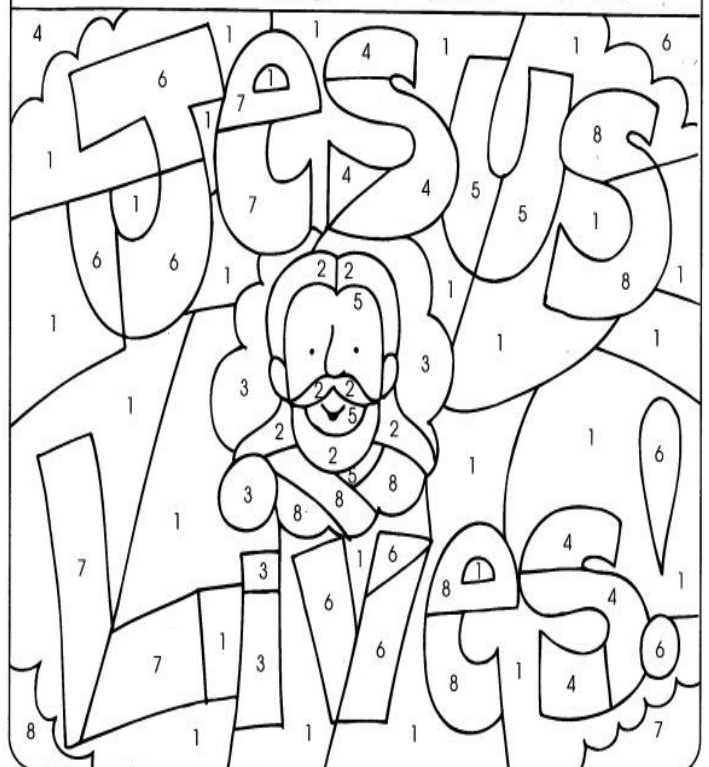

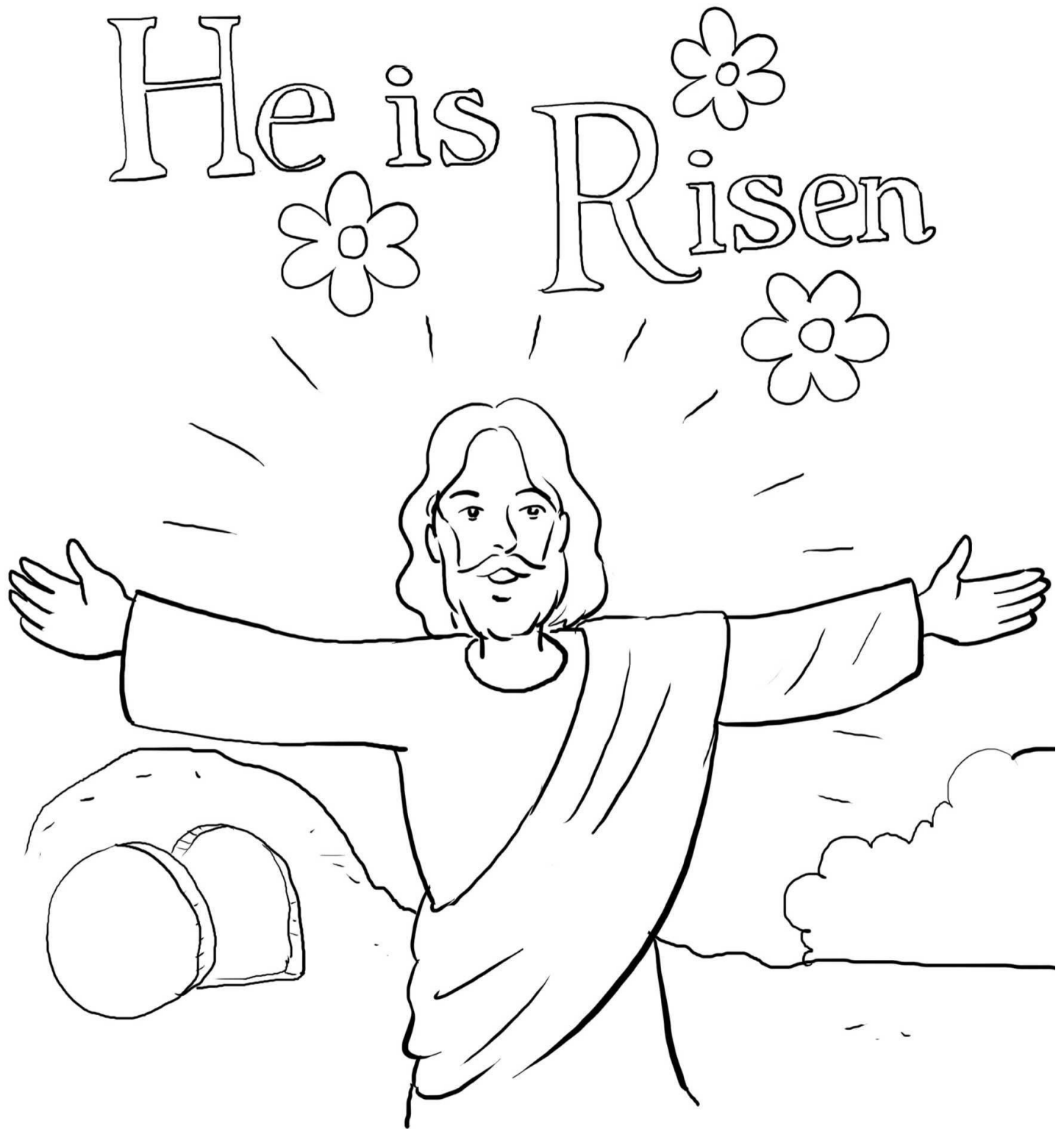
